## **OBJECTIVES:**


- 1. To examine the infrastructural facilities provided by the tourists.

A questionnaire was designed for the assessment of economic impacts consists of 11 questions or indicators. The total 50 questionnaire were filled up by them. The response of each question or indicators was rated.

## **STUDY REGION:**

The beautiful attracting coastal town Alibag or Alibagh, is located in the Raigad district of Maharashtra. Alibag is the headquarters of the Raigad district. The beautiful sandy beaches of Alibag and its historical heritage, has made the place immensely popular among tourists from all parts of India and abroad. Geographically, Alibag town is situated at coordinates of 18°38' North latitude and 72°52' East longitude. Alibag town is at the tip of the ridge that goes into the Arabian Sea. The town covers an area of 1.813 Square kilometer. The Alibag town is under the Alibag Municipal Council of the Raigad district with a total population of 20,743 as per the 2011census. Male population is around 51% (10,646)and women consisting of 49% (10,097) of the total count. The average literacy rate is around 84% which is higher than the national average of 59.5%. The literacy rate for men and women are 54% and 46% respectively.
